## ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES

- All entries must be handmade and work of the exhibitor.
- Class tickets must be attached securely to all exhibits.
- All work must be clean and finished neatly. Quality will be the first consideration in judging.

## CRAFT

- 395.** Small article of LEGO – **NEW** in 2023 small models only, no bigger than 20cm x 20cm x 20cm. An original/unique design by the creator would be preferred
- 396.** Handcrafted Teddy bear or stuffed animal Any fabric, minimum height 20cm (head to toe), must be articulated
- 397.** Article of polymer clay – **NEW** in 2023 e.g., small figurine, piece of jewellery, trinket box, fridge magnet, small vase, pot, keychain etc
- 398.** A piece of handmade jewellery- any style or medium not restricted to just beaded items. Mounted or presented in a way which can be easily displayed. (earrings, necklace, brooch, bracelet, ring etc.)
- 399.** Paper craft- e.g. paper flowers, origami, paper toll, quilling, decoupage etc (no cards or scrapbooking)
- 400.** Christmas decoration- any medium not larger than a shoebox e.g., tree decoration, table decoration etc.
- 401.** Article featuring resin/resin pour – **NEW** in 2023 e.g. Cutting board, key chain, drink coasters, photo frame. Jewellery etc.
- 402.** Article featuring buttons- e.g. use buttons to create a picture, an object decorated with buttons
- 403.** Article featuring mosaic- no bigger than 30cm x 30cm. e.g. drink coaster, tile, vase, photo frame, garden decoration etc.
- 404.** Article featuring punch needle embroidery – **NEW** in 2023

No bigger than 30cm x 30cm. e.g. Wall decoration/hanging, cushion, pillow cover, small item of clothing, handbag etc.

- 405.** Article of leadlight - e.g. window pane, sun catcher, lamp shade, jewellery box, garden decoration etc.
- 406.** Diamond bead painting- any size or shape, framed or unframed - not larger than an A3 (including the frame)
- 407.** Article of macrame – any size or shape (e.g. dream catcher, plant hanger, wall hanging, shopping bag, keychain etc) Wall hanging not any larger than A3
- 408.** Craft article not mentioned above  
If you have made a handmade craft article which doesn't fit in any of the above categories, you can enter it here.

## ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES

There are two parts for entering these sections. Secondly the exhibits need to be delivered to Stacey Pavilion (or the Secretaries office if delivered at times when the Stacey Pavilion is not open).
