To be conducted at the Beef Cattle Ring

Open to competitors who must be under 25 years on 1st May in

the year of the final championship at the Royal Adelaide Show. Juniors and Seniors will be judged separately. The winner of the Senior competition at the 2022 Jamestown Show will move to the final to be held at the 2024 Royal Adelaide Show.

Points for Competition:

1. All competitors will be allowed 5 minutes to assess the exhibits, which will be paraded for the competitors.
2. Each competitor will then be asked to line up the exhibits according to their rankings and express his/her view of the cattle exhibited to the over judge and spectators. 2 minutes should be sufficient time to express your views.
3. Competitors should have reasons organised and emphasise the most important points.
4. The main objective for the competitors is to give their reasons and to inform the judge what they saw and compared in each animal.
5. Competitors should make comparisons between animals rather than describe individuals.
6. Competitors should be neatly attired - points will be deducted for poor presentation.
7. Four beef animals will be used for the comparison.
